### **Ranfurly Sprinkler Ban Lifted**

The sprinkler ban placed on the Ranfurly town water supply 5 days ago has now been lifted. Adequate storage volumes have now been re-established in the town reservoir. However, the normal water restriction of odd / even day irrigation still remains in place.

The response from the community was excellent, with water consumption dropping significantly over the period, which included some of the hottest days this year.

Although the sprinkler ban has been lifted, residents need to use water conservatively to ensure adequate storage levels are maintained.
