Water Meter Reading

Council would like to remind residents on metered properties that the next round of water meter reading is now underway. This is the second of the three readings taken per annum.

Most consumers can expect to be well within their allocated water allowance. However, consumers who have already used more than their annual water allocation will be billed for any excess use.

Council's Utility Services Manager, Peter Greenwood said "We would encourage all residents to check their meters regularly so as to be aware of their water use and try to keep within their annual water allocation. We also find doing a regular check is an effective way of detecting any water wastage caused by leaks.
