Safety Improvements planned for Waenga Drive

Safety improvements to Waenga Drive, between Barry Avenue and Murray Terrace, in Cromwell will get underway on Monday 16th August.

Peter Cuthbertson, Council's Roading Engineer said "The work is expected to take approximately one month to complete and will involve widening the south side of the street between Barry Avenue and the Police Station.

Car parking and traffic movements will be affected during the duration of the project, however every effort will be taken to ensure disruption is kept to a minimum.

Alternative car parking is available on the surrounding streets and the Travellers' Rest car park off Murray Terrace. Please allow extra walking time in your journey.

This project has been a community initiative and crash data confirmed that improvements were needed to this section of the street.

Once completed, people will notice increased carriageway and safety margin width which will result in improvement to traffic, cyclist and pedestrian safety while still retaining car parking.
