## **Draft Waste Minimisation and Management Plan for Central Otago**

### **Summary of Information**

Notice Pursuant to Section 83 (1) of The Local Government Act 2002

#### ***Background***

The Waste Minimisation Act (2008) requires all Councils to adopt a Waste Minimisation and Management Plan before July 1<sup>st</sup> 2012. A Waste Assessment must also be publically notified as part of the consultative procedure.

The Draft Waste Minimisation and Management Plan contains the following elements:

- The vision and objectives for waste minimisation in our community.
- An overview of the current facilities and services to minimise and manage waste, and an overview of the materials that are being diverted from landfill and disposed of across the district.
- Ten strategies for achieving the objectives for waste minimisation and management in our community.
- The proposed actions, implementation methods and funding in support of the strategies.
- The proposed methods for monitoring progress against the plan.

#### ***Proposal***

Adopt the Waste Minimisation and Management Plan and associated strategies and action plans for implementation in Central Otago.

#### ***Statement of Proposal***
