

DRAFT DOG CONTROL POLICY - SCHEDULE ONE

(a) AREAS IN WHICH DOGS ARE PROHIBITED:

Town Centres and Retail Areas:

- The Cromwell Shopping Mall, bounded by Murray Terrace, Barry Avenue and Waenga Drive

Areas designated by the Department of Conservation:

- The Department of Conservation is in the process of classifying all its land as either 'Closed' or 'Open' Dog Areas. Land designated as Open Areas will give free access to dogs, possibly with some conditions such as keeping the dog on leash at all times. Closed Dog Areas will prohibit access by all dogs, except those with permits and will include all National Parks; wilderness areas; ecological, sanctuary, scenic, nature, scientific and national reserves; plus wildlife sanctuaries, refuges and reserves.

(b) AREAS WHERE DOGS ARE TO BE CONTROLLED BY LEASH:

Town Centres and Retail Areas:

Alexandra

- The entire Alexandra township, with the exception of those urban areas where dogs are prohibited, as defined in Section 2(1) of this By-law and in Schedule 1(a) above.

Clyde

- The entire Clyde township, with the exception of those urban areas where dogs are prohibited, as defined in Section 2(1) of this By-law and in Schedule 1(a) above.

Cromwell

- The entire Cromwell township, with exception to those urban areas where dogs are prohibited, as defined in Section 2(1) of this By-law and in Schedule 1(a) above.

Naseby

- The entire Naseby township, with exception to those urban areas where dogs are prohibited, as defined in Section 2(1) of this By-law and in Schedule 1(a) above.

Ranfurly

- The entire Ranfurly township, with the exception of those urban areas where dogs are prohibited, as defined in Section 2(1) of this By-law and in Schedule 1(a) above.

Roxburgh

- The entire Roxburgh township, including the beach of the Clutha River within the town's boundaries, with the exception of those urban areas where dogs are prohibited from entry altogether, as defined in Section 2(1) of this By-law and in Schedule 1(a) above.

Areas designated by the Department of Conservation:

- The Central Otago Rail Trail, between Alexandra and Clyde.
- Flat Top Hill conservation area, near Butcher Dam, Alexandra.

(c) AREAS DESIGNATED AS DOG EXERCISE AREAS

Alexandra

- part of the Alexandra Town Belt Recreation Reserve, between State Highway 85 and the Pine Lodge Motor Camp, and between the Alexandra Cemetery Reserve and Dunstan Road.
- part of the Alexandra Pines, north of the electricity pylons and between State Highway 8 and the Clutha River, as well as the area between Molyneux Park and the Alexandra Golf Course.
- the "Linger and Die" - i.e., the area of land between Rivers Road and the Manuherikia River

(N.B. subject to Crown approval).

Clyde

- Sunderland Street road reserve between Orchard Street and Hospital Street.

Cromwell

- land surrounding the Chafer Beetle Reserve, south of Cromwell.
- small plantation between the Cromwell refuse tip and the Cromwell cemetery.
- the Pines area, bounded by Gair Avenue, McNulty Road and Flora Street.
- the Victoria Park reserve area on Alpha Street between the Ray Street intersection.

Naseby

- the eastern side of the Hogburn Creek, from the Hogburn bridge extending north to the town boundary (i.e., unformed street known as Lomond Street).
- area adjacent to the entrance of the Naseby Refuse Tip, off Channel Road.

Ranfurly

- the unformed area of Caulfield Street on the southern boundary of the Maniototo Golf Course from Tyrone Street to Drumglass Street.
- vacant land from the corner of Pery and Tyrone Streets to the eastern area of the showground and northern boundary of the Ranfurly Cemetery.

Roxburgh

- No areas defined to date.
