#### PROPOSAL TO STOP UNFORMED LEGAL ROAD. THEN VEST IT IN COUNCIL AS LOCAL PURPOSE (AMENITY) RESERVE

Date of Notice: 18 January 2024

Pursuant to Section 342, and the Tenth Schedule, of the Local Government Act 1974, the Central Otago District Council (Council) hereby gives notice of its intention to stop the unformed legal road (currently known as Flora Street) as described below in the First Schedule.

The land described in the First Schedule is not required for current or future roading purposes and is to be stopped, then vested in Council as Local Purpose (Amenity) Reserve, to align with its current use and development.

The continuity of the existing services will be protected and preserved by the registration of easements on the applicable title(s).

### First Schedule (Road to be Stopped, then vested in Council as

#### 🖲 Temporary Road Closures

#### Alpha Street - Cromwell

One Lane of Alpha Street in Cromwell will be closed between 07.30am and 5pm Monday 22 January 2024 to 2 February for potholing survey works for Cromwell Watermain. The lane closure is between Neplusultra Street and State Highway 8B. Alternate routes are available via Neplusultra Street and Barry Avenue out onto the Highway. Road will be opened during nonworking hours at night.

Miners Lane (Upper Service Lane) - Clyde

Miners Lane (the service Lane only) will be closed between Monday 22 January 2024 to Friday 2 February for drainage works and road improvements. Access will be available for residents only via Sausage Alley (Private Road). This access is not suited for Heavy

**Dungannon Street - Ranfurly** 

The Northbound Lane of Dungannon Street in Ranfurly will be closed between Knowles Crescent and John Street on 25 January 2024 for up to 14 days for wastewater renewals. The southbound lane will remain open. All residents will have access to their properties at all times and medical centre ambulances will be catered for. A detour route will be signposted via John Street -Northland Street - Thomas Street - Dungannon Street.

#### Dye testing - Manuherekia River 22-23 January 2024

As part of the Omakau wastewater treatment plant consent, Central Otago District Council is undertaking an ecological assessment of the Manuherekia River. This includes releasing a florescent dye into the river to evaluate the treatment plant discharge mixing zone. The dye is non-toxic, biodegradable and safe for the environment. The test is scheduled for Monday and/or Tuesday (22-23 January) next week, pending weather and river conditions, on the Manuherekia River downstream of the Omakau wastewater treatment plant.
