KEY TO COLLECTIONS

MIXED RECYCLING

Your recycling is sorted by people not just a machine, so wash all items before they go in the YELLOW bin.



GLASS RECYCLING

Clean glass bottles and jars in the **BLUE** bin only. No lids.



HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH

Don't put anything in the **RED** bin that could be recycled, is hazardous or may damage the collection truck eg. scrap metal.

TOWARDS ZERO WASTE AND A SUSTAINABLE CENTRAL OTAGO



We are using too much stuff. It isn't doing the planet any favours and it's costing us lots of money. If we bought less stuff, fewer packaged and single-use items, and if we recycled more and composted everything organic from our gardens and kitchens we would not have much to deal with at the kerbside. This is great for the planet, good for our pockets and much better for future generations.

REDUCE

Only use your red bin for items you can't avoid, reuse or recycle. Avoid single use items.

Choose products with little or no packaging, or with reusable or recyclable packaging.

Say no to plastic bags. Take reusable bags instead. Buy durable and long lasting products that can be repaired.

RECYCLE

Put all clean recyclable material in your yellow bin. See below for what you can recycle.

RFCOVFR

Compost organic material including garden trimmings. lawn clippings and food scraps.

Use a Bokashi compost bin or a worm farm. Use your local greenwaste only drop-off site.



CLEAN PLASTIC BAGS AND PLASTIC WRAP

Place in one bag and put in your YELLOW recycling bin. No loose plastic bags as they clog the machinery.



NEWSPAPERS. MAGAZINES, JUNK MAIL, CARDBOARD BOXES

Everything in the **YELLOW** bin must be clean material. Unfold and flatten cardboard. No cardboard that is waxed, lined with plastic or foil, or that has been contaminated with food scraps. No coffee cups, juice or milk cartons, no polystyrene trays.



ALUMINIUM AND TIN CANS

Wash and squash to maximise space in your YELLOW bin. Lids can be included.



MBERED PLASTICS

All plastics with recycling numbers 1,2,3,4,5,6,7 go in your YELLOW bin. Wash, squash, lids can stay on.





GLASS BOTTLES AND JARS

Washed bottles and jars go in the BLUE bin. All glass colours together. Lids go in yellow bin. No windscreens, crockery, ornaments, light bulbs, mirrors or window glass.
