Place your bin close to the kerb or roadside and half a metre away from other bins, poles, fences, letterboxes etc.



Do not overfill, bin lid must be closed. Extra items placed on top or next to the bin will not be collected.



Your nearest transfer station for greenwaste, additional recycling or refuse is Ranfurly (Drumglass St). Some charges apply.



Bins should be out by 7am to guarantee pick up.

KEY TO COLLECTIONS

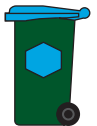
MIXED RECYCLING

Your recycling is sorted by people not just a machine, so wash all items before they go in the **YELLOW** bin.



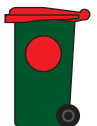
GLASS RECYCLING

Clean glass bottles and jars in the **BLUE** bin only. No lids, cardboard, food, plastic or cans.



HOUSEHOLD RUBBISH

Don't put anything in the **RED** bin that could be recycled, is hazardous or may damage the collection truck eg. scrap metal.



PUBLIC HOLIDAY (No collection)



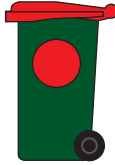

What goes in your **RUBBISH** bin?

- ✓ All general household waste that cannot be recycled
- ✓ Plastic wraps & foil wraps
- ✓ Disposal cups, plates & cutlery
- ✓ Polystyrene takeaway containers & meat trays
- ✓ Nappies & sanitary products
- ✓ Broken glass, wrapped
- ✓ Some plastic items

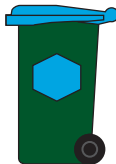


No Thanks

- ✗ No recyclable material items such as paper & cardboard
- ✗ No garden waste
- ✗ No building materials
- ✗ No chemicals & hazardous items
- ✗ No medical waste
- ✗ No hot ashes
- ✗ No gas bottles
- ✗ No paints - oil - liquids
- ✗ No scrap metal
- ✗ No rocks - bricks - soil

What goes in your **GLASS** bin?

- ✓ **ONLY GLASS** bottles and jars



No Thanks

- ✗ No lids - put in yellow bin
- ✗ No plastic or silver lined bags
- ✗ No pyrex, ceramics, mirrors and window glass
- ✗ No light bulbs
- ✗ No cardboard
- ✗ No food eg lemons
- ✗ No paper eg cigarettes
- ✗ No cans or tins
- ✗ No plastic

What goes in your **RECYCLING** bin?

- ✓ Plastic bottles & containers
♻️ (Number 1 – 7) OK
- ✓ Wash - squash - lids off - lids in bin OK
- ✓ Tins & cans - wash - squash
- ✓ Lids in bin OK
- ✓ Empty aerosols
- ✓ Clean paper eg newspapers, magazines
- ✓ Envelopes & junk mail
- ✓ Clean cardboard eg egg cartons
- ✓ Packaging - flatten cardboard
- ✓ Clean aluminium foil



Best place for plastic bags, bubble wrap, silver lined packets, bread bags, cling film, courier packs etc is the **SOFT PLASTIC SCHEME at NEW WORLD** - these are recycled more effectively through this scheme.

No Thanks

- ✗ No soft plastics
- ✗ No food & garden waste
- ✗ No polystyrene takeaway containers
- ✗ No meat trays (no number ♻️ 6 or compostable meat trays)
- ✗ No tetrapaks
- ✗ No electrical or electronic items
- ✗ No textiles or clothing or shoes
- ✗ No unwashed plastic bottles or containers
- ✗ No food contaminated cardboard eg pizza boxes
- ✗ No medical waste
- ✗ No batteries
