Temporary Road Closures

(Pursuant to the Transport Vehicular Traffic Road Closure Regulations 1965)

Notice is given that the following roads are proposed to be closed for the purpose of the Blossom Festival in Alexandra:

- Friday 25 September 2026:** Walton St, Rivers St and Thompson St from 3pm to 9pm. Detour via SH85 and Tarbert Street.
- Saturday 26 September 2026:** Bantry St, Shannon St, Killarney St and Centennial Ave from 6am to 6pm. Detour 1: SH8 to SH85 to Omakau via Royal Terrace, Chicago St, and Station St. Detour 2: SH8 to Roxburgh/Dunedin via Clutha St, Ventry St, Matau St, Bringans St, Dunorling St.

Residents will have access to their properties with the assistance of traffic marshals.

Any person objecting to the proposal can lodge their objection and reasons in writing before 5pm on Saturday 29 August 2026 to the Central Otago District Council, 1 Dunorling Street, PO Box 122, Alexandra.



Harvest at Bannockburn Industrial Subdivision

Harvesting of the forestry block at the Bannockburn Industrial Subdivision is scheduled to begin the week of 24 August 2026.

The site was identified in the Long-term Plan for future development as part of Council's strategy to increase Cromwell's industrial land supply and generate commercial returns for the community.

Contractors are expected to be onsite for approximately three weeks, weather dependent. Fencing is planned to be installed this week before harvesting begins.

De-stumping and site tidy-up will take place following the completion of harvesting.
