

Alcohol Restrictions in Public Places Bylaw 2025

Alexandra Blossom Festival
Schedule 2 of the bylaw - Alcohol Restriction Zones (Blossom Festival) - extends the alcohol restriction zone from Alexandra to Raes Junction for the festival weekend.
The restrictions apply from 12am (midnight) on the Thursday before the event until 12am (midnight) on Saturday.
The restriction zone covers Alexandra, Clyde and Cromwell, as well as the Teviot Valley area between Alexandra and Raes Junction (see the Teviot map below).

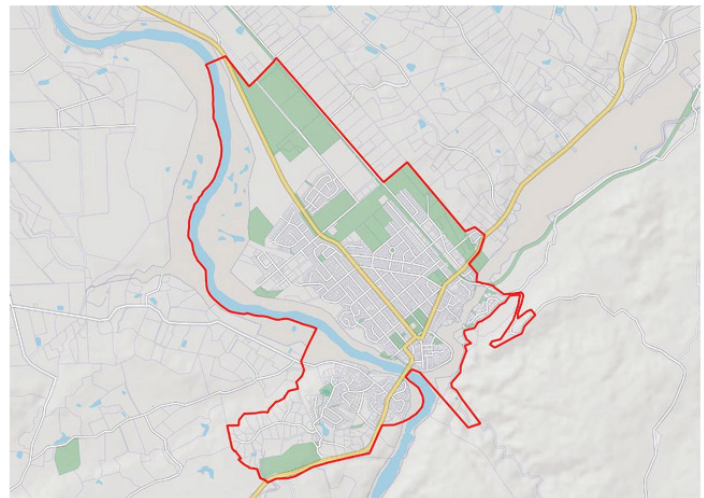
Merino Shears Weekend
Schedule 4 of the bylaw - Alcohol Restriction Zones (Merino Shears Weekend) - establishes an alcohol restriction zone in Alexandra.
The restrictions apply from 12am (midnight) on the Thursday before the Merino Shears weekend until 12am (midnight) on Saturday.
See the map of Alexandra below for the area covered.

- For both events above this relates to:**
- (a) The consumption of alcohol in any Alcohol Restriction Zone during any Specified Period;
 - (b) The possession of alcohol in any Alcohol Restriction Zone during any Specified Period;
 - (c) The bringing of alcohol into any Alcohol Restriction Zone during any Specified Period; and
 - (d) The consumption and possession of alcohol in a vehicle in any Alcohol Restriction Zone during any Specified Period.
