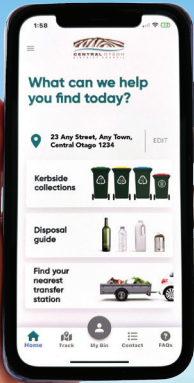

Proposed Land Development and Subdivision Code of Practice

Council is proposing a new Land Development and Subdivision Code of Practice 2026.

The proposed Code will replace Council's current NZS 4404 Addendum (2008) and set the engineering and infrastructure standards for subdivision and development across the Central Otago district.

It provides guidance and requirements for developers, engineers, surveyors and contractors involved in designing and constructing development infrastructure. It also sets expectations for the quality, performance and long-term maintenance of infrastructure that may become Council assets. Council is seeking feedback on the proposed Code before making a final decision on its adoption. Consultation opens on 7 September and closes on 5 October 2026.
