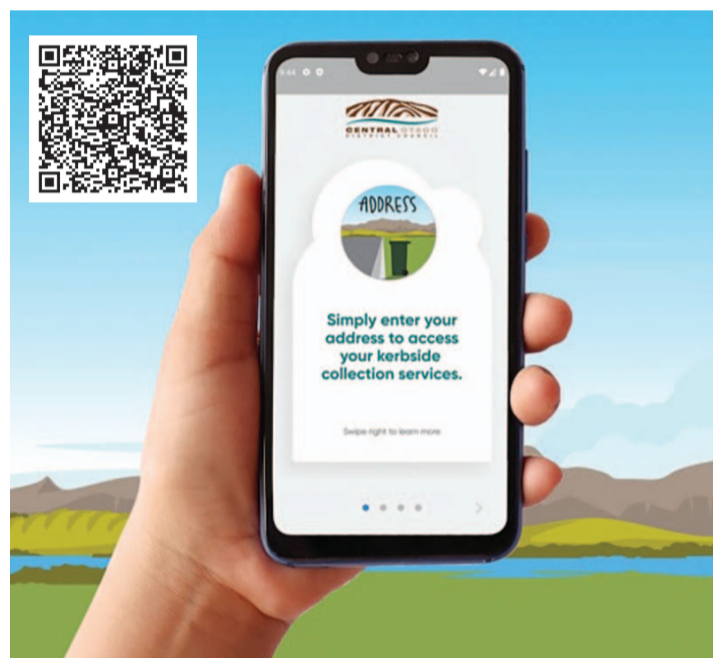
CODC Bin App Update: Now with Holiday Collection Reminders!

Temporary road Closure – Industrial Area, Cromwell

Wolter Crescent, Hughes Crescent, Pinot Noir Drive, Connelly Way, Chardonnay Drive and part of Cemetery Road are proposed to be closed on Sunday 23rd February 2025 between 6am – 6pm.

This is for the purpose of the annual Central Otago Motorsport Club Street Sprint.

Access to this area will remain closed for the duration of the event with alternative routes to Cromwell via McNulty Road.

Temporary Speed Restriction on Sandflat Road, Cromwell

The Central Otago District Council Roding Team has identified that vehicle volume and speed are contributing to accelerated deterioration of the unsealed section of Sandflat Road, causing the surface to become 'cobbled' and requiring additional rolling and grading.

To address these issues and improve the road's condition, a temporary 60km/h speed limit will be implemented on Sandflat Road, Cromwell from 9 December 2024. This measure will help reduce maintenance demands while maintaining safe road conditions. The Council will continue to monitor the road closely and take action as needed to address any further issues that may arise.

Council had sought co-funding as part of its 2024–2027 funding application to the New Zealand Transport Agency to seal the remaining unsealed section of Sandflat Road. Unfortunately, this project was not approved for co-funding and has been deferred to the 2027–2030 period.

'Watch the Drops' this Summer

With summer heating up, it's crucial that we conserve water to ensure a sustainable supply for everyone, especially during the hotter months when water usage significantly increases.

Why we implement summer water restrictions?

Water conservation and restriction notices are implemented to manage the high demand for water during the summer months, to ensure that our treatment plants can keep up with demand and meet our regulatory requirements to protect our water sources. During summer, the largest water use comes from outdoor activities, including the irrigation of gardens, lawns and some of our community green spaces.

The Watch the Drops programme is designed as a traffic light system to help each community understand the existing level of demand on the water network and where we need to be taking extra care to use of water wisely.

By following these restrictions, we can ensure that our community has enough water to meet everyone's needs throughout the summer.

Let's work together to conserve water and protect this precious resource.
