Proposed Plan Change 19 – Further Submission on behalf of Freeway Orchards

This is a further submission in relation to multiple submissions on Proposed Plan Change 19 (PC19) to the Operative Central Otago District Plan (CODC).

Freeway Orchards has an interest in the proposal that is greater than the interest the general public has, the grounds for saying this being Freeway Orchards made an original submission (submission 30) on PC19.

PPG on behalf of Freeway Orchards wish to be hearing in support of my further submission.

If others make a similar submission, PPG on behalf of Freeway Orchards will consider presenting a joint case with them at a hearing.

Freeway Orchards opposes the following submissions with the reasons listed below:

- **Submission 36** – The reason for opposition is that the intention of the PC19, and in particular the medium density residential zone is to be located in walkable proximity to town centres and community facilities, of which the Freeway Orchards site is. Restricting potential development so close to the town centre would contravene the NPSUD (Objective 1-4 and 8) and result in potential indirect negative social, economic and environmental outcomes for Cromwell. Freeway Orchards seek that the submission as it relates to non-support of the proposed zoning of the Freeway Orchards site be disallowed.
- **Submission 129** – The reason for opposition is that the provision of Medium Density Zoning provides Central Otago with the opportunity to increase housing supply to meet future demand, without relying on sprawling low density residential zones into productive or sensitive landscapes. Freeway Orchards seek that the whole of the submission be disallowed.
