10 May 2024	RFI Response provided by Helios. New information submitted: - Confirmation of the 10 degree limitation on backtracking and the implementation of screening to remove all yellow glare from the road network (Response to Request 7) - The Updated Landscaping Mitigation Plan with all gaps in boundary vegetation infilled (Attachment 2, Boffa Miskell Memorandum dated 30 April 2024) - Landscape Assessment with the full glint and glare modelling results appended as requested by neighbouring landowners during ongoing consultation post submission of the consent application
13 November 2024	Green Glare clarification memorandum prepared by ITP sent to Council (to provide definition of green glare and confirm this is not a safety risk)
26 May 2025	- Written confirmation of removal of BESS from Application - Written confirmation from applicant acknowledging ecology and landscape peer reviews were underway - Provision of the ITP Renewables updated glint and glare assessment incorporating 10 degree backtracking limitation to confirm planting requirements for the Landscape Planting and Maintenance Plan
28 May 2025	Landscape Planting and Maintenance Plan submitted.
