The area is an outstanding natural landscape and the application has lots 9,11,12,13,21,22,23,24,27,28,29,31,32, and 33 partially or fully in a designated Landscape Protection area which is intended to be set aside for conservation values. It is in breach of 7 Council standards which collectively are designed to protect environmental values. In particular destroying 41,000 square metres of kanuka and cushionland which is the habitat of at risk species is a major brea
