## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

The applicant, Jillian Sullivan and Gypsy Trustees Limited, seeks resource consent for a non-complying two-lot subdivision and a restricted discretionary land use activity to establish a residential building platform and associated earthworks at 3381 Ida Valley-Omakau Road. Lot 1 will comprise an area of 0.678ha and Lot 2 will be the balance lot with an area of 7.398ha. Lot 1 is intended for future residential development and Lot 2 will retain an existing dwelling on the site. Development controls are proposed for Lot 1. The land is zoned Rural Resource Area under the Central Otago District Plan. The subject site has an identified flood risk and the land is also identified as Land Use Capability 3 according to Manaaki Whenua Land Care Research Mapping.

The application includes an assessment of environmental effects.
