The Central Otago District Council has received an application from Central Otago Queenstown Trail Network Trust to undertake earthworks and construct an underpass, retaining structures, and bridges in association with the construction, operation, and maintenance of a walking and cycling trail extending from the Citroen Rapid on the Kawarau River to a section of legal road at the western end of Felton Rd, Bannockburn.

The application lodged with the Central Otago District Council (RC200286) is located on private and public land generally in the vicinity of the true right bank of the Kawarau River, extending from the Citroen Rapid on the Kawarau River to a section of legal road at the western end of Felton Rd, Bannockburn. The land is legally described as Bed of Kawarau River (parcel ID 3201240), Legal Road, Section 2 SO 23940, Section 6 SO 485617, Section 11 SO 485617, and Part Section 23 Block IV Cromwell SD.

The application includes an assessment of environmental effects.
