

County of Manitowish.

Byelaw No. VI

Whereas at a duly convened special meeting of the Council of the County of Manitowish held at the County Chambers in the Borough of Naseby on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of December one thousand eight hundred and eighty nine at two o'clock in the afternoon the following resolution was passed namely—

"Whereas it is expedient in the interests of the  
"County and for the purpose of providing for the  
"good rule and government thereof that byelaws  
"should be made regulating the traffic of horses  
"cattle and sheep over two several bridges within  
"the County of Manitowish to wit— the bridges  
"respectively known as Allen Bridge and the  
"Pasarova Bridge; and whereas the Clerk of the  
"County has been requested by the Chairman of the  
"County by requisition in writing signed by the  
"Chairman of the County and delivered to the Clerk  
"of the County to call a special meeting of the  
"County Council of the County of Manitowish for  
"the purpose of taking into consideration the  
"advisability of passing such a byelaw, and such  
"requisition specified the day for which such  
"special meeting was to be called to wit— the  
"eleventh day of December, one thousand eight  
"hundred and eighty nine at two o'clock in the  
"afternoon; and a notice in writing of the calling  
"of the said special meeting under the hand of the  
"Clerk of the County was sent to each Councillor  
"seven clear days at the least before the day  
"appointed for the said special meeting being the

"said eleventh day of December One thousand eight  
"hundred and eighty nine, and the said notices  
"specified the business for which the said special  
"meeting was called. Now therefore the County  
"Council of the County of Maniototo being in special  
"meeting assembled on the said eleventh day of  
"December One thousand eight hundred and  
"eighty nine at the hour of two o'clock in the  
"afternoon doth hereby resolve order and determine  
"that for the purposes aforesaid the following bye-  
"laws be made and the same shall come into  
"force on the first day of April One thousand eight  
"hundred and ninety.

#### Allen Bridge.

"No person shall at any one time cross over the  
"bridge within the County of Maniototo erected  
"across the Manukeriri River near the Hawdon  
"Station and known as Allen Bridge with a greater  
"number of horses cattle and sheep than 3 horses  
"3 cattle and 30 sheep nor shall any person drive  
"lead or take over the said bridge at any one time  
"a greater number of horses cattle and sheep than  
"3 horses three cattle and 30 sheep, and if any person  
"shall do or commit any of the acts or things  
"aforesaid such person shall be liable for every such  
"offence to a penalty the amount of which shall be  
"in the discretion of the Court inflicting the same  
"but so that such penalty shall not exceed the sum  
"of Five pounds.

#### Patearoa Bridge.

"No person shall at any one time cross over the  
"bridge within the County of Maniototo erected  
"across the Taieri River known as Patearoa Bridge  
"with a greater number of horses cattle and sheep  
"than 2 horses 2 cattle and 20 sheep nor shall any

"person drive lead or take over the said bridge at any  
"one time a greater number of horses cattle and  
"sheep than 2 horses 2 cattle and 20 sheep; and  
"if any person shall do or commit any of the acts  
"or things aforesaid such person shall for every  
"such offence be liable to a penalty the amount  
"of which shall be in the discretion of the Court  
"inflicting the same but so as such penalty shall  
"not exceed the sum of Five pounds.

And Whereas the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January One thousand  
eight hundred and ninety at two o'clock in the  
afternoon was the time appointed for confirming  
the said resolution; and whereas public notice of  
the said meeting so appointed to be held on the 29<sup>th</sup>  
day of January One thousand eight hundred and  
ninety as well of the business to be transacted  
thereat and of the time from which the said bye-  
laws are to take effect was published once in each  
of the four weeks following the said meeting of the  
eleventh day of December One thousand eight hundred  
and eighty nine in the Mount Ida Chronicle a  
newspaper circulating in the said County of  
Manitota and a notice of the said meeting so  
appointed to be held on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of January  
One thousand eight hundred and ninety was  
given to each Councillor of the County of Manitota;  
and whereas a copy of the proposed bye law was  
deposited at the office of the County and was open  
to the inspection of the public during office hours  
for at least twenty one days immediately preceding  
the said 29<sup>th</sup> day of January One thousand eight  
hundred and ninety: Now therefore the County  
Council of the County of Manitota doth hereby  
in pursuance of the powers conferred on us by "The  
Counties Act 1886" and of every other power therein

enabling resolve order and determine that the  
aforesaid resolution passed at the said meeting  
of the Council held on the eleventh day of December  
One thousand eight hundred and eighty nine be  
and the same is hereby confirmed.

I hereby certify that the foregoing is a true copy of a
