AN 12/11 The Princent County Council The petition of the undersigned rate payers in Vincent County respectfully showeth That a large portion of the northern division I the county is infested with Reas which are very distructive to the cheep running in that district and that notistletanding the large numbers of these birds which have been killed by the runholders, it is believed that more sheep are killed by them now than ever, owing to the birds having become more skillful in thei work of destruction, and that unlip come extra exertion is made to exterminate these pests, it will soon be impossible to run sheep on the country in question with any hope of profit. That the General Government have granted a sum of money to assist in this extermination available to any County which may make a similar grant from County Funds, and that pour this cource 2 - per head is now being paid in take County for every Rea killed in that County and runholders in that County are now with this assistance paying to this employes 3/ to 3/6 head for every bird they may kill. Runholders in Uncent County have been paying por 1/ 5 2/ but to ensure the work of externation being carried on regrously, it would be nicepay & pay the same as in Lake County Four petitioners therefore respectfully request the Council to take the mice pary steps to obtain a chare of the Government
