- Letter to the Colonial Treasurer from Vincent Pyke requesting when he may expect Vincent County will receive its proportion of the confiscated Land Fund of Canterbury and Otago, which has been ordered and agreed should be paid over – 1879
- Letter from the Secretary of the Treasury, Wellington, James Gavin, to the Chairman Vincent County Council, forwarding for his information a copy of a circular which has been addressed to the Chairman of the County Councils in the Provincial District of Canterbury, and also the Chairman of the Roads Boards interested in the recent distribution of surplus Land Revenue of that District – 18 March 1880
- Letter from the Treasury, Wellington, to the Chairman of the Vincent County Council informing him that in view of the intention of the government to ask for authority next session to deem certain subsidies issued as Unauthorised Expenditure of the Consolidated Fund to the counties of Take?, Maniototo, Tuapeka, Vincent and Waimate for the half year ended 31 December 1877 to have been issued under section 7 of the Financial Arrangement Act 1877 and Section 8 of the Financial Arrangements Act 1876 thus rendering the said counties eligible to participate in the division of the two fifths of the undivided portion of the Surplus Land Revenue of the Provincial Districts of Canterbury and Otago under Section 9 of the Financial Arrangements Act 1876 – 9 February 1880
- Correspondence between the committee appointed by several County Councils and Roads Boards, Christchurch, and the Chairman Vincent County Council regarding obtaining payment of the portion of the Canterbury Land Fund due to them but was withheld by the Colonial Government.
