Council transfer station recycling services expand

From Monday 26 February 2024 electronic waste recycling will be available at all four Council transfer stations in Alexandra, Cromwell, Ranfurly and Roxburgh.

This recycling service will accept all forms of TVs, computers, laptops and computer equipment, printers and photocopiers, household appliances, stereo systems, and gaming consoles.

Waste (used engine) oil recycling will also be introduced on Monday 26 February at the Alexandra and Cromwell transfer stations.

Temporary Road Closures

Lodge Lane, Clyde

Will be temporarily closed for the Council to trial the viability of converting space to a permanently pedestrianised area. Trial closure will be between 1 March 2024 and 1 April 2024. Alternate routes are available via Holloway and Sunderland streets.

Charlemont Street, Ranfurly

The northern end of Charlemont Street in Ranfurly will be closed between State Highway 85 and Alexander Street from 11 March 2024 until June 2024 for the wastewater renewals programme. All residents will have access to their properties at all times with onsite traffic management staff assisting.

A detour route will be signposted via:

Mitchell Street – Hanrahan Street – State Highway 85 State Highway 85 - Hanarhan Street - Mitchell Street - Alexander Street - Charlemont Street.

Sunderland Street, Clyde

Will be closed for the annual Easter Food and Wine Harvest Festival, From 7am to 6pm Sunday 31 March 2024.

Detours will be available via Holloway, Fache and Naylor streets. Residents will always have access to their properties. Footpaths will be open for pedestrians and cyclists.

Māniatoto Library late night trial


Tonight our Thursday late night (5pm-6pm) trial ends. We will be looking at the visitation numbers to reassess demand for extended hours in the coming months.
