Temporary Road Closures

Alpha Street, Cromwell

We have adjusted the timing for installation of the pipe works for the Cromwell Rising Main project. A section of Alpha Street will be closed on Monday 11 March and reopen Friday 22 March 2024, which will also allow for resurfacing. Please see the digital VMS board onsite for updates on Alpha Street closures. The closure is between Neplusultra Street and Sunhaven Cove.

Detour routes will be available via: State Highway 8B, Barry Avenue, Neplusultra and Alpha streets. Residents will have access via the detour available either side of the closure.

Three Brothers Road, Teviot

Three Brothers Road, Teviot will be closed for two days from 8am to 5pm on Thursday 21 March and Friday 22 March 2024. This is for the purpose of Motorsport testing. Residents will have access to their properties at all times and the road will be open outside of the above hours.


