Central Otago District Council Community Boards are now seeking applications to the following Promotions Grants:

CROMWELL 2015/16

Applications are invited from community groups within the CROMWELL ward to the Cromwell Promotions Grant for projects to be funded within the 2015/16 financial year (July 15 to June 2016).

VINCENT 2015/16

Applications are invited from community groups within the VINCENT ward to Alexandra and Earnscliffe/Manuherikia Promotions Grant for projects to be funded within the 2015/16 financial year (July 15 to June 2016).

TEVIOT 2014/15

This is the first and only round of applications for the 2014/15 year. Applications are invited from community groups within the TEVIOT ward to the Roxburgh Promotions grant to 30 June 2015.

MANIOTOTO 2014/15

This is the second and final round of applications for 2014/15. Applications are invited from community groups within the MANIOTOTO ward to the balance of the Maniototo Promotions grants to 30 June 2015.

Funds are available for promotion projects that:

- Help meet community needs/desires for events, facilities or activities that enhance the experiences of locals and visitors
- Support community strategies that have as their goal the social, environmental, economic and cultural enhancement of the ward area
