Coastguard advises that due to changes in maritime repeater channels to meet international use of these frequencies, Radio Spectrum Management has required us to change the frequency of the repeater located on Mt Horn (VHF marine channel 28) which provides coverage on Lake Dunstan and some surrounding areas.

From 1 February 2019 the new VHF channel will be VHF marine channel 01.

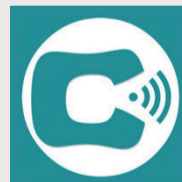
