In accordance with the (Local Government Act 1974, Schedule 10)

The Central Otago District Council proposes to close a section of Melmore Terrace to ordinary vehicle traffic, between Achil Street and the cul de sac at Old Cromwell Township.

The closures will be between 4.30pm and 9.00pm on Saturday 26 October 2019.

No detour is available for this section of road.

Omakau Wastewater Dye Testing

Omakau wastewater dye-testing has been scheduled to take place from the week of 16 September.

Treated wastewater from the Omakau wastewater treatment plant is discharged from the wastewater oxidation ponds to the Manuherikia River through a dispersion plume. Council must assess how well the plume is performing as part of the resource consent to discharge into the river.

Non-toxic red tracer dye will be discharged at different dilutions from the Omakau wastewater treatment plant at a controlled rate and measurements will be recorded, through the use of a drone, in order to identify the behaviour and effectiveness of the wastewater discharge plume.

This is a routine and safe testing method, and is non-toxic so will have no effect on the flora and fauna or the environment surrounding the river.
