Otago Central Rail Trail section closure



Our Lake Dunstan Water Supply and Clyde Wastewater Pipelines Project contractor Fulton Hogan has closed a small section of the Otago Central Rail Trail from this week until construction work is finished.

The Trail is currently closed between Trail Journeys at the Clyde Railhead and Young Lane to allow our contractors to work on construction of that section of the Lake Dunstan Water Supply and Clyde Wastewater pipelines.

A detour is in place and signposted. The closure will be between 7am Monday to 6pm Friday until construction works are finished. The trail will be open during the weekends.

Lode Lane Toilets closure

The Lode Lane Toilets in Cromwell are scheduled for maintenance work from Monday 2 September. While this public facility is out of action there will be portaloos in place about 20m away.
