1. There is no statutory time frame for allocation of a hearing date following the close of further submissions. The Council must give its decision on the Plan Change no later than two years from the date of notification.
  2. No hearing date has been allocated yet.
  3. The Council has appointed independent commissioners to hear, and make a recommendation to the Council on submissions / further submissions.
  4. The Council expects the Hearing's Panel will issue a minute addressing the following matters:
    1. Evidence Timetable: The timetable will be set by the Hearings Panel. The timetable will address the Council s42A report and any other Council evidence to be circulated, Requestor evidence, and submitter evidence.
    2. Other procedural matters - such as how evidence can be lodged, presentation at hearing, allocation and scheduling of hearing times for submitters, and key Council contacts.
